



**COURSE DESCRIPTION**

### **Course Type**

Performers Course, Level 6 Diploma in Professional Dance

### **Course Duration**

The course duration is over 3 Years, 5 days per week or 6 days for those working at Advanced 1 Classical level and lower.

### **Course Goal**

The goal of this course is to train and educate dancers to the highest possible standard, equipping them with the necessary technical, performance and dance education skills, including transferable skills to fulfil their potential for a career in the performing Arts Industry, in a safe and caring environment.

The training covers the following:

- Key + Supporting Skills in the 3 main dance genres: Classical Ballet, Jazz and Contemporary
- Level 6 Diploma in Professional Dance Modules/ Lectures/Employability skills/Research/ Reflection
- Optional DDE Modules
- Additional dance genres, Tap, Spanish dance, Commercial Street dance
- Vocal studies
- Classical Repertoire / Mime
- Pointe work
- Virtuosity
- Choreography
- Analysis of Technique
- Audition Technique
- Rehearsals towards Performances
- Annual Tour of Allegrodance Touring Company

This course includes self-study material, self- assessment questions and interactive lessons.
